

Algorithmic selection from the Permanent Collection

Our first encounter with the Permanent Collection for this project was a digital file - a linguistic interface between us and the physical works. The long (and wide) spreadsheet recorded information in columns under headings including Accession Number, Attribution, Object Category, Material, Object Description, Title and Acquisition Method. The use of language in representing the Collection became a point of interest and we discussed various methods of extracting a selection through the application of a set of rules. Finally, we decided to exhibit Untitled works. There was no particular time period or single reason, we discovered, for this resistance to using language. There were artists who titled work Untitled, who gave no title, or who considered the works preparatory exercises, like prototypes with a hidden generative function.

A number of practical considerations arose in terms of the volume of works, availability and special loans to the City Gallery. A narrower set of rules was devised to reflect our interests in language, space and technology. Firstly, we confined our scope to wall-based works and to works without a subtitle such as *Untitled (White Angel)*, not to be confused with the Gallery's distinguishing references such as *Untitled* (Head and Torso). Secondly, a spatial rule was introduced to confine the selection to three walls of the Permanent Collection Room - demarcated by a slightly different colour. And thirdly, a chronological order was proposed for the hanging of works. Here we found incomplete records hindered an exact display design and we depended on the memory of the curator of the Collection. The final arrangement in columns represent year (wall #3), decade (wall #2) and estimated date of production (wall #1).
